The China Stock Market & Accounting Research (CSMAR) Database provides access to China stock markets data and financial statements of all companies listed on the Shanghai Stock Exchange and the Shenzhen Stock Exchange. Features of CSMAR include the functionalities of crosstab query, as well as thematic databases, e.g. Analyst Forecasts, Corporate Governance, and Capital Structure.
